

Redland Bay State School Personally Owned Digital Devices Parent Checklist



Preparing for your child to bring their device to Redland Bay State School

- € Create an **Apple id and Password** or **Microsoft Account**, if you haven't already got one (we advise you **NOT to tell your child** these details) to access and download apps from the App Store/Windows Store. You can choose to use an existing Apple id / Microsoft Account in order to share apps or set up Family Sharing.
- € Discuss elements of the Redland Bay SS Personally Owned Digital Devices Policy and Responsible Use Agreement with your child and ensure your child understands the expectations contained in this document.
- € Ensure that your child understands that they are **not to capture photo, video or audio unless advised to do so by their class teacher.**
- € Have purchased a **protective cover and keyboard** for your child's device and considered a tempered glass screen protector.
- € Loaded all the required apps on your child's device as per the **required apps** list, found in the Redland Bay SS Personally Owned Digital Devices Policy and Responsible Use Agreement and on the Redland Bay SS website.
- € You and your child are aware of the login details, username and password, for the following:
 - o **School Network** (same as email)
- € Other apps may request a username and password to be created, if you are unsure please see your child's class teacher.
- € **Email setup** to access school email, download the OWA app for iPad devices and enter your child's school username and password to complete activation.
- € Ensure **Office 365 Student Advantage** has been loaded onto my child's device as per the departmental web link found on the Redland Bay State School website under the BYOx tab.
- € Regularly update your child's device, (apps and operating systems) to ensure the latest versions are installed.
