**\$242,178\***

## This funding will be used to

- Lift outcomes for our top students. (Increase students in U2B Reading (Yr 3) to 47%; (Yr 5) to 35%)
- Provide specific support programs for all students falling below NMS (or equivalent)
- Close Gap in Yr 3 Indigenous reading results
- Lift outcomes for students with a disability
- Increase the level of differentiated teaching programs
- Increase school attendance to >94%

## Our initiatives include

- SSP, Words Their Way, Seven Steps to Writing, Guided Reading, Repeated Reading
- Building Teacher capacity in Collaborative Inquiry and Explicit Instruction
- Specialist reading & writing mentors
- Before School intensive reading support
- Indigenous Reading Club (before school)
- Establishing an intensive behaviour support program to re-engage 'at risk' students
- Intensive monitoring of school attendance

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Providing additional teacher aide time to support Literacy Teams in Reading (\$232,000)
- Providing additional teacher time to support Yr 5 Writing/Conferencing (\$18,500)
- Building Teacher capacity (PD & Coaching) in Spelling, Numeracy, Reading pedagogies, Explicit Instruction (\$18,500)
- Establishing a Student Engagement Officer & Behaviour Support Zone (\$16,500)
- Introducing new literacy support programs (\$16,500)
- Purchasing addition technology to enhance differentiation (\$20,000)
